\* The Written Projects and Practical Assessment are graded on the basis of Pass(+), Merit(+) or Distinction:

Pass	=	15/25	60/100
Pass +	=	16.5/25	66/100
Merit	=	18/25	72/100
Merit +	=	19.5/25	78/100
Distinction	=	21/25	84/100

An overall Course Grade of Pass(+), Merit(+) or Distinction is awarded on completion of all components bar the case studies, as part of the written exam results. It is arrived at through calculating the percentage of points gained out of an overall total of 400 (300 for those exempt from A&P), as follows:
